RACE NOTES:

High School standouts Tom Bober and Mike Weintraub were driving through the SUNY campus when they saw the 24 man field line up for the start of the RRC Sunday Road Races. "Whats this " they asked, and after a few taunts from the runners, they parked their car and joined the field. With no warmup, they tied for first in the one lap race with a 6 second lead over Pat Stewart. With Gary Nelson resting from a 21 mile workout the previous day, Tom Osler had little opposition in the 11.28 mile run. His time of 64:49 was far off Nelson's course record of 62:32.
