The weather was ideal: temperature, 36°, wind light, course dry. The long run, billed as a "half-marathon", was held on a new, gently rolling two loop course utilizing the SUNYA primeter road and the roads of the neighboring State Office Fuilding Complex, which on careful measuring turned out to be 12.7 miles. Most of the runners appeared to prefer the new course to the four-perimeter course used last year.

Two who may not have cared so much for the new course were winner Jim Shrader and runnerup Jim Bowles. Shrader led all the way and by an impressive margin in the Learly part of the race, but twice went off the course and found himself running back towards the other runners. Bowles also lost the course at one point, so was awarded second place despite finishing in a tie with Don Wilken. Ted Bick (40) won the Masters division by withstending the steady pressure of Sam Gratch (49) of Utica.

Paul Rosenberg won the 3 mile by breaking away from Don Shrader in the last 3/4 mile.
