It was a cold day, and snow and ice covered the first half mile of the course, yet the first six finishers in the 12.5 Mile Road Race beat the Boston Marathon qualifying standard of 85 minutes. The course featured four perimeter loops of the SUNY Campus with the traffic circle added to make these loops 3 miles rather than the usual 2.86 miles. These longer loops seemed preferable, and will be used in the future. Twelve year old Stephen McConnell took the 2.86 mile run, and his brother Gregg ( 8 years old ) finished third.
